Presentation guidelines:

Presentations

Can be:

- a) blend or merge cranial work with another modality
- b) present material on craniosacral therapeutics (new or old)
- c) enhance practitioner's skills by deepening their awareness and ability to be present with a client.
- d) present your own discoveries through your clinical experience
- e) explain an historical or philosophical aspect of cranial therapeutics

Cannot be:

- a) affiliated with selling or promotion of any products, written material or educational seminars
- b) any sole treatment modality that does not have a basis in cranial work
- c) any copy written material that the presenter does not have permission to present to our group

Lecture Material

Lecture material should have a direct application for those practicing cranial therapeutics. It is helpful for presenters to explain their cranial terminology, as our fellow supporters are from different branches of the cranial tree and are not necessarily conversant with all the terms used to describe working with the craniosacral system.
